Regarding Initiatives on Conflict Minerals,

The issues pertaining to minerals such as tin (Sn), tantalum (Ta), tungsten (W), gold (Au), cobalt (Co), mica, and others have been recognized as significant social challenges, as they pose potential funding sources for organizations engaged in inhumane activities, including child labor, within conflict-prone regions and high-risk countries like the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). To promote responsible mineral sourcing that avoids contributing to these inhumane activities, within functional film products like WILMINA[®], we are committed to the following measures:

- We refrain from utilizing conflict minerals associated with inhumane activities.
- For materials utilizing target minerals, we encourage procurement from certified smelters through proper supply chains, having undergone audits by third-party entities.
- We conduct investigations based on industry-standard norms to confirm the procurement of target minerals from compliant smelters.
- In cases where target minerals are sourced from refining facilities carrying risks outside of compliant smelters, we request our primary suppliers to transition to sourcing from compliant smelters.
- Should any materials, not limited to conflict minerals, be identified as linked to inhumane activities, we will promptly cease their usage, formulate mitigation strategies, and enact them.
